

PHOTOGRAPHY – CLASS DESCRIPTION/SUPPLIES

Level: 1, Age Requirements: 12 & Up, Format: Classroom; Instructor Permission Required: No

DESCRIPTION:

Students will learn the basics of producing a quality photograph: the importance of lighting, contrasting values, composition and rule of thirds, filling the frame, subject matter, posing subject for portraits, individual, and group shots. We will also study the art of creating a still life in the style of the masters and photographing it, creating original sources to paint. This is a hands-on class to learn how to manage ISO, Shutter speed, and Aperture and where they are located on the camera.

SUPPLIES:

Student must have their own digital camera and be able to photoshare either through facebook or email. Each student should bring a 4-8 gig flash drive. There will be a \$3 per print charge at the end of the term. All photos will require a matte with an 8" x 10" opening.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

Students will be evaluated on their ability to follow directions and complete assignments.
